



## Digital screening in Trollhättan

In connection with the Filmdays at Trollhättan "Trolleywood" - Sweden , Aug 14-18, the Swedish filmdistributor and contractor of 260 cinemas Folkets Hus och Parker held a digital preview of a new feature film produced by Sonet. "Executive protection", the sequel to Anders Nilsson's film "Zero Tolerance", is a clever and fast-paced thriller about the industrialised world closing its eyes on growing organised crime. It also features some of Sweden's top actors. But "Executive protection" has not much to do with a "standard" movie since the "film" was shot with Cine-Alta 24p camera's and sound processed by DTS.

It was encoded on an EVS server from EVS Digital Cinema in Belgium. The SX10 projector from Digital Projection was delivered by Informationsteknik, Stockholm.
